

BOBBLE COWL



SIZE

- · One size (see notes)
- · 23.5" circumference
- 16.5" high

MATERIALS

- 3 skeins Lang Yarns Amira (93% Cotton, 7% Nylon; 109 yards/100m per 1.76oz/50g skein), shown in 933.0096 or approximately 300 yards of lightweight worsted or aran yarn
- US 8 (5mm) 24" circular needles (or size needed to obtain gauge)
- 1 stitch marker
- · Tapestry needle

GAUGE

4 inches = 17 sts and 26 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)

k = knit

mb = make bobble



STITCH GUIDE

Bobble Stitch

Step 1: *Yo, k1, repeat from * three times in the same st (you should have 5 sts were you initially had one); turn work so wrong side is facing you.

Step 2: Knit the 5 bobble sts; turn work so right side is facing you.

Step 3: Knit the first two bobble sts together; place this st back onto the left needle.

Step 4: Pass the remaining three sts, one at a time, over the knit-together st and off the needle, as if to bind off.

Step 5: Knit the remaining bobble st.

NOTES

If you wish to modify the pattern, be sure to cast on a multiple of 5 sts to adjust circumference. If you wish to adjust the length, continue in pattern of adding two rows of knit sts between bobble rows and alternate where you start make the bobble (k2, mb, k2 then k4, mb).

THE PATTERN

Cast on 100 sts using the long-tail method. Place a marker and join for working in the round, careful not to twist sts.

Round 1: Knit.

Round 2: Purl.

Rounds 3 & 4: Repeat rounds 1 & 2.

Round 5 & 6: Knit.

Round 7: *K2, mb, k2, repeat from * to end of the round.

Ronds 8-11: Knit.

Round 12: *K4, mb, repeat from * to end of the round.

Rounds 13-18: Knit.

Round 19: *K2, mb, k2, repeat from * to end of the round.

Rounds 20-27: Knit.

Round 28: *K4, mb, repeat from * to end of the round.

Rounds 29-38: Knit.

Round 39: *K2, mb, k2, repeat from * to end of the round.

Rounds 40-51: Knit.

Round 52: *K4, mb, repeat from * to end of the round.

Round 53-66: Knit.

Round 67: *K2, mb, k2, repeat from * to end of the round.

Round 68-83: Knit.

Rounds 84: *K4, mb, repeat from * to end of the round.

Round 85-102: Knit.

Round 103: Knit.

Round 104: Purl.

Rounds 105 & 106: Repeat round 103 & 104.

Round 107: Knit.



Use Elizabeth Zimmerman's sewn bind off.

FINISHING

Use tapestry needle to sew in ends. Wash and block, carefully, if you prefer.
