

GARTER STITCH HAT



THE MATERIALS

- 1 skein of Cascade Eco Cloud or Cloud Yarn
- US #9, 16" Circular Needles
- US #9, Double Pointed Needles
- 8 stitch markers, with one a different color to mark beginning of round

THE PATTERN

Foundation: Cast on 72 stitches to 16" circular needles. Place stitch marker and join for working in the round, being carful not to twist stitches.

Round 1: Knit Round 2: Purl

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 until work measures 7 inches from cast on edge ending on a purl round.

Place a stitch marker every 9 stitches.

Decrease

Round 1: *K7, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 2: Purl all stitches.

Round 3: *K6, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 4: Purl all stitches.

Round 5: *K5, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 6: Purl all stitches.

Round 7: *K4, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 8: Purl all stitches.

Round 9: *K3, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 10: Purl all stitches.

Round 11: *K2, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 12: Purl all stitches.

Round 13: *K1, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Finish

Cut yarn leaving a 24-inch tail, thread onto tapestry needle and pull through remaining stitches. Make a pompom and attach.

Weave in your ends and block as desired.
